

Ranked Choice Voting

Fellow Republicans and Conservative Friends,

According to [HB2004](#), a new law enacted by the Oregon State Legislature during the previous Legislative Session, Oregon voters will decide this year whether to implement ranked choice voting for all state and federal elections. If voters approve the measure, Oregon will become the third state to use the model for federal and statewide elections. **Make no mistake, ranked choice voting would be devastating to the integrity of Oregon's elections.**

HB2004 - Relating to ranked choice voting; and providing that this Act shall be referred to the people for their approval or rejection.

Catchline/Summary - Establishes ranked choice voting as voting method for selecting winner of nomination for and election to offices of President of United States, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer and Attorney General.
